The Mills County Board of Supervisors met this 22nd day of October, 2013, in the Mills County Courthouse in Glenwood with Richard Crouch, Lonnie Mayberry and Ron Kohn present.

Motion by Mayberry, seconded by Crouch to approve the October 28, 2013 Agenda and the October 15, 2013 minutes as presented.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0.

Motion by Crouch, seconded by Mayberry to approve the accounts payable as presented.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0.

Engineer Kevin Mayberry reported no requests for utility permits.

IT Director Patrick Binns reported that he has not received necessary bid information on AS400 servers and will put this item on a future board agenda.

Mary Gunderson, representing the Glenwood Chamber of Commerce, presented information about the funding of flower pots on light poles around the Glenwood square in the spring of 2014. Gunderson explained that local businesses are purchasing ten pots, guaranteed for ten years, and was wondering if the Board would purchase pots for the Courthouse grounds. The Chamber would provide future plants and the City of Glenwood would provide watering and storage of pots.

Motion by Mayberry, seconded by Crouch to approve up to \$1300 for the purchase of six planters to be located on light poles on the Courthouse grounds.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

Electrician Ben Lundstrom and Darrin Whatcott, Mills County Building Inspector, joined the Board for general discussion and discussed concerns and status of electrical upgrades to the courthouse wiring system currently taking place. All parties agreed to make certain that all upgrades meet current electrical standards.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, they adjourned to meet on Tuesday, October 29, 2013.
