The Mills County Board of Supervisors met this 17th day of September, 2013, in the Engineer's building in Glenwood with Richard Crouch, Lonnie Mayberry and Ron Kohn present.

Motion by Mayberry, seconded by Crouch to approve the September 17, 2013 agenda as presented and the September 10, 2013 minutes as corrected.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

There were two utility reports from the County Engineer to report this week.

- 1) Tile drainage crossing L68, Marh Avenue and the Wabash trace
- 2) Mid-American Energy across Noyes just east of 360<sup>th</sup> Street

Motion by Mayberry seconded by Crouch to approve Charlene Johnson as office manager position in the amount of \$22 per hour effective September 9, 2013.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

The Engineer updated the Board on road projects currently in progress.

Motion by Crouch seconded by Mayberry to approve Blake Webel to mow the roadway from Jameson from Old Highway 34 to the western city limits of Emerson and to provide proof of insurance to the County.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

Motion by Mayberry seconded by Crouch to waive the Indian Creek Museum permit fee for the barn project. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

Malvern Area Betterment Association representatives Tom Mulholland and Jay Burdic were present to request County funding for economic development projects in Malvern using LOST funds. They are considering a low interest USDA loan that would need to flow through a 501C3 account. The funding will be used to construct a building to house a full-time doctor and City of Malvern and MABA offices. This funding would also be used for projects that would attract people to the Malvern community to live.

Because of the variety of projects they are dealing with, Supervisor Kohn stated that MABA and Malvern city officials need to identify and prioritize projects and then present a specific request for economic development funds for the Board to consider. The Board tabled the request at this time.

Motion by Mayberry seconded by Crouch to authorize the County Attorney to fill the vacated part-time assistant county attorney position with Christopher Tinley, beginning October 1, 2013 at a rate of \$27.88 per hour for an amount not to exceed \$29,000 annually. Tinley passed the background and physical exams.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

IT Director Patrick Binns was present to discuss a VPN software purchase.

Motion by Crouch seconded by Mayberry to approve the purchase the VPN stable security software in the amount of \$8,305 to be used in deputy laptops.

The E911 and the Sheriff departments will be asked to contribute as well.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

The Board received the August month end reports.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, they adjourned to meet on Tuesday, September 24, 2013.
