The Mills County Board of Supervisors met this 21st day of October, 2014, in the meeting room at the Mills Count Courthouse in Glenwood with Lonnie Mayberry, Richard Crouch and Ron Kohn present.

Motion by Crouch, seconded by Kohn, to approve the October 21, 2014 agenda as presented and the minutes of October 14, 2014 as presented.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

Motion by Kohn seconded by Crouch to approve the accounts payable as presented.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

Engineer Kevin Mayberry presented information about Roads Department activities and policies.

Motion by Kohn, seconded by Crouch, to have the Board Chairperson sign the Performance Bond for Project #BRS-CO65(93) – 60-65, bridge replacement at 330th Street over the West Nishnabotna River.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

Sherrill Dashner was present to visit with the Supervisors and Engineer about improvements to Rist Avenue. Road improvements that will allow better drainage will be made after the water level in the area goes down.

Sherriff Eugene Goos provided the Board with information about jailers needed to complete the jail staffing.

Motion by Kohn, seconded by Crouch, to approve the hire of Jordan Wendell, Barbara Hammer, and Judy Groves as jailers since they have passed all required tests and employment screenings. Their salaries will be \$26,360 each and each will begin work on October 27, 2014.

County Treasurer, Becky Killpack, requested the appointment of Jill Ford, a current employee, to be a Treasurer's Department deputy.

Motion by Crouch, seconded by Kohn, to approve the appointment of Jill Ford as a deputy in the Treasurer's Department effective November 1, 2014, at a salary of \$42,066, which is 80% of the Treasurer's salary.

Recorder Lisa Tallman requested the hire of a part time staff person for the Recorder's Office.

Motion by Kohn, seconded by Crouch, to approve the hire of Tamera Lundy, who has passed all required tests and employment screening, to a part time position for the Recorder's Department. The salary is to be \$13.00 per hour for 24-29 hours per week and she will start work on October 22, 2014.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

County Attorney, Tricia McSorley presented to the Board interrogatory information pertaining to the lawsuit filed by Montgomery County Memorial Hospital against the County.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, they adjourned to meet on Tuesday, October 28, 2014.
