Motion by Crouch seconded by Kohn to approve Resolution 14-20 – Establishment of Speed Limit Zones and Stop Signs on the roads that Mills County has taken over from the State of Iowa.

RESOLUTION 14-20

ESTABLISHMENT OF SPEED LIMIT ZONE & STOP SIGNS

WHEREAS, under the provisions of chapter 321.345, Code of Iowa, The Board of Supervisors and the County Engineer are empowered to designate the locations and erection of Stop Signs, and,

WHEREAS, certain highways have a Transfer of Jurisdiction from State to County Roads effective November 10, 2014, and

WHEREAS, certain highways maybe designated as through highways with erection of stop signs at specific locations furnishing access there to or the designation of any intersection as a stop intersection and erect like signs at one or more locations of access to such intersections, and,

WHEREAS, the Mills County Board of Supervisors may determine and declare reasonable and proper speed limits on county roads, and,

WHEREAS, Mills County recognizes locations and existing speed limits as designated on the transferred roads,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mills County Board of Supervisors in session this 18th day of November, 2014 recognized as the official locations of Nine (9) stop signs at various intersections of Mills County Roads, and that said intersections will be one (1) or two (2) way stops as shown on the attached Mills County Maps.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of Mills County on this 18th day of November, 2014 recognized the existing locations of such speed limits as the official location as shown on the attached Mills County Map.

Motion carried on a Roll Call vote:

Engineer Mayberry, Sheriff Goos, County Attorney Tricia McSorley and EMA/Acting E911 Communications Director Larry Hurst were present for discussion of the snow and ice removal Ordinance. It was determined that Engineer Mayberry will meet with all deputies and dispatchers to go over the policy and procedures of snow and ice removal. The Engineer will also do a story in the local newspaper and information will be put on the Mills County website.
