The Mills County Board of Supervisors met this 20th day of May, 2014, in the Board of Supervisor's meeting room at Mills County Courthouse in Glenwood with Lonnie Mayberry, Ron Kohn and Richard Crouch present.

Motion by Kohn, second by Crouch to approve the May 20, 2014 agenda and the May 13, 2014 minutes as presented.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0.

Motion by Crouch, seconded by Kohn to approve the accounts payable as presented.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0.

There were two utility permits to report this week:

- 1) MidAmerican Energy for electrical service on Raleigh Road
- 2) New Century Builders for a water main tap at 52094 229th Street.

Engineer Mayberry updated the Board of Supervisors on various road projects and roadside management practices. The Board of Supervisors shared concerns regarding the trucks hauling dirt on Barrus Road on Sundays.

Darin Whatcott, Building & Zoning Director was present to provide information to the Board for the Agricultural Exemption Appeal. Since this property is within the City's 1 mile radius jurisdiction, Whatcott will notify and inform this individual that they must apply for a variance with the City Board of Adjustment. Whatcott will present this on behalf of Mills County.

Motion by Crouch seconded by Kohn to approve the 2nd reading of Ordinance 14-01 - Recodification of County Ordinances with the changes that were made to the appropriate sub sections.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

Motion by Kohn seconded by Crouch to approve the hiring of Matthew Staiert as a Deputy Sheriff with a start date of June 2, 2014 at a salary of \$44,322 providing he passes all physical & psychological testing.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

Motion by Crouch seconded by Kohn to approve a renewal liquor license to Liezo Charro Rodriguez for a class B beer permit which includes wine coolers and outdoor service. Rodriguez performed all of the required clean-up to receive this license approval.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

Sandy Winton was present to discuss Mills County assisting with the lighting of the Courthouse grounds during the holiday season. Winton stated that the Chamber of Commerce has done this in the past but no longer wants to and requested that the Board of Supervisors take it over and be responsible to light up the courtyard. The Board asked what group would be willing to help with this. The Board members will attend the next meeting to learn more about this before they commit.

The Board received the Sheriff's Department April transaction report.

The Board received correspondence from Prochaska and Associates on an updated budget summary for the Law Enforcement Center.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, they adjourned to meet on Tuesday, May 27, 2014.
