The Mills County Board of Supervisors met this 8th day of December, 2015, in the meeting room at the Mills County Courthouse in Glenwood with Supervisors Lonnie Mayberry and Ron Kohn present. Richard Crouch was absent.

Motion by Mayberry seconded by Kohn to approve the December 8, 2015 agenda and the December 1, 2015 minutes as presented. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 2 Nays: 0

Motion by Mayberry seconded by Kohn to approve accounts payable as presented.
Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 2 Nays: 0

Darin Whatcott, Building and Zoning Official was present to share the Mills County Engineer's building addition plans with the Board. Some adjustments need to be made on the plans. Whatcott will bring them back to the Board when they are received.

Mills County Recorder, Lisa Tallman updated the Board on the following:
The part-time employee is working out very well.
The Recorder's office has increased revenues to \$70,000 due to e-submission.
The Recorder's office is considering digitalizing Recorder's books for preservation.

Tallman also explained that Recorders have been working legislatively to increase the amount of money their office receives when they provide state services for local residents. She will continue to update the Board regularly.

Deb Breeding, President of the Malvern Area Betterment Association, joined the session to explain the organizations role in the Malvern community.
Motion by Mayberry seconded by Kohn to approve a commitment to the Malvern Area Betterment Association for \$2500 to assist with 2016 advertising and \$500 for a 2016 gold membership which will be taken from L.O.S.T. monies.

Richard Crouch joined the session at this time.
