The Mills County Board of Supervisors met this 20th day of August, 2015, in the meeting room at the Mills County Courthouse in Glenwood with Supervisors Ron Kohn and Lonnie Mayberry present. Richard Crouch was absent attending a MHDS Meeting.

Motion by Mayberry seconded by Kohn to approve the August 20, 2015 agenda as presented and the August 11, 2015 minutes as corrected. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 2 Nays: 0

Assistant Engineer Richard Parks was present for the meeting. Engineer Mayberry was attending a meeting in Ames.

There was one utility permit to report this week:

- 1) Century Link – Phone line on Epperson Avenue

Discussion was held on Chapter 25 of the Code of Ordinances – 25.7(a) – Private roads shall not be permitted.

A Mills County subdivision is interested in having a discussion to pursue a request for a private road. Mayberry wants to share information on this and will bring it to the Board of Supervisors for consideration of an amendment to the Ordinance.

Motion by Mayberry seconded by Kohn to approve a joint project with Montgomery County on H-34 approximately ½ mile to ¾ of a mile for widening.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 2 Nays: 0

Parks updated the Board on roads that are being patched in Mills County. He also gave an update on the Bunge road project and other projects that the Secondary Roads department is presently working on.

Motion by Mayberry seconded by Kohn to approve the hiring of Jessica Lovell as a jailer.

All required physical, psychological and drug testing has been passed. The starting salary is \$27,020 with a start date of August 20, 2015. Lovell will attend the academy in September.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 2 Nays: 0

Motion by Mayberry seconded by Kohn to approve a liquor license renewal for Fairview County Club for a Class C liquor license for outdoor and Sunday service.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 2 Nays: 0

The Board received the Mills County Sheriff department's July Treasurer's Report of Receipts, Transaction reports and Reconciliation report.

The Board also received the Mills County Recorder's July Report of fees.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, they adjourned to meet on Tuesday, August 25, 2015 in the EOC Meeting Room located downstairs in the Mills County Courthouse. This is due to State Auditors being present for two weeks in Mills County.
