The Mills County Board of Supervisors met this 25th day of August, 2015, in the EOC meeting room at the Mills County Courthouse in Glenwood with Supervisors Richard Crouch, Lonnie Mayberry and Ron Kohn present.

Also present was Jamie Sommerville and sons Ian and Gage. Ian and Gage are trying to earn citizenship badges for Boy Scouts and attending a meeting was one of the criteria.

Motion by Mayberry, seconded by Kohn, to approve the August 25, 2015 agenda and the August 18, 2015 minutes as presented. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0.

Motion by Kohn, seconded by Mayberry, to approve the Accounts payable as presented. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0.

Engineer Mayberry took the Board of Supervisors to view a driveway variance request located near 60697 Kidd Road.

During the Board's site visit, Ian and Gage Sommerville were given a tour of the Courthouse offices and given an explanation of what each department does for the County.

There were no utility permits to report this week.

Motion by Mayberry seconded by Kohn to approve the FY2015 Annual Report. Engineer Mayberry will file it with the Iowa Department of Transportation. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

Mayberry reported that Bunge Avenue was re-opened on Saturday, August 22, 2015. Sta-Bilt will be in Mills County on September 1, 2015 sealcoating Mills County roads. This should take approximately a week. Sta-Bilt may stay in the County to do work for the Cities in the area. The M-16 Road overlay project will begin on September 21, 2015 and patching will be done on August 31, 2015.

Donna Crum requested the use of the Mills County Courthouse on February 1, 2016 for the Iowa Caucus. Motion by Mayberry seconded by Kohn to deny the use of the Courthouse on February 1, 2016 for the Iowa Caucus due to security concerns during after-hours in the Courthouse. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

Motion by Mayberry seconded by Kohn to approve the purchase of a tablet and cover in the amount of \$895.05 for the General Relief/Veteran's Affairs Department, and will be paid from grant funds. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

Motion by Kohn seconded by Mayberry to authorize FMLA papers for a Mills County employee. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

Motion by Kohn seconded by Mayberry to approve Castle Unicorn for a Class C liquor license renewal with commercial for catering, living quarters, outdoor service and Sunday sales. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

The Board had Sheriff Goos, Chief Deputy Paulsen, County Attorney Tricia McSorley and EMA/E911 Communications Director Larry Hurst join the session for general discussion regarding security provisions that need to be made for the Mills County courthouse and employees. It was decided that the South doors will be locked and on court dates the Sheriff's department will use metal detectors to scan all people before entering the building. The Board feels this is something that needs to be done and when the security committee members meet further security measures will be disclosed.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, they adjourned to meet on Tuesday, September 1, 2015.
