The Board of Supervisors met this 23rd day of February, 2016, in the meeting room at the Mills County Courthouse in Glenwood with Supervisors Ron Kohn and Lonnie Mayberry present. Supervisor Crouch was in Washington D.C. for the National Association of County Officials conference.

Motion by Mayberry, seconded by Kohn to approve the February 23, 2016 agenda as presented and the minutes of the February 16, 2016 as corrected.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 2 Nays: 0.

Motion by Mayberry, seconded by Kohn to approve the accounts payable as presented.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 2 Nays: 0.

Assistant Engineer Richard Parks was present in the Engineer's absence.

There were no utility reports this week.

Motion by Mayberry seconded by Kohn to request reimbursement for BROS-CO65(97)—8J-65, Montague Road Bridge over Waubonsie Creek from the D.O.T. in the amount of \$39,884.34.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 2 Nays: 0

Parks report to the Board that the roads in Mills County are currently extremely soft. The frost boil is coming out. He also reported that the Mills County roads crew is hauling rock.

Motion by Mayberry seconded by Kohn to authorize Darin Whatcott, Building and Zoning Official to start the bidding process for the addition on the Engineer's building with a due date of April 1, 2016.

Joe and Joanne Cheney were present to request an opportunity to put a Farmer's Market at the Highway 34 at the interchange of the old D.O.T. site owned by Mills County. The Board will discuss this with the County Engineer and the County Attorney before making a decision.

Motion by Kohn seconded by Mayberry to authorize Supervisor Mayberry to sign the Juvenile Detention 28E Agreement renewal. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 2 Nays: 0

Motion by Mayberry seconded by Kohn to approve the FMLA papers from a Mills County employee effective February 22, 2016. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 2 Nays: 0

Sheriff Goos and Office Manager Mary Bateman were present to inform the Board that the radio in the deputy vehicle had been repaired so there is no need to purchase a new one.

Goos also discussed concerns with budget cuts to the Sheriff's department 2016/2017 budget.

The Board stated they are still working on the budget.

Linda Washburn, Glenwood Chamber of Commerce Executive Director and John Lorson, Glenwood Chamber Vice-President was present to request that Mills County continue to fund the Chamber of Commerce at the current funding level. The Board stated that they have planned this expense in the 2016/2017 budget.

The Board had a budget work session at this time. They have been working with Mills County department heads on the 2016/2017 budget prior to finalizing.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, they adjourned to meet on Tuesday, March 1, 2016.
