The Board of Supervisors met this 25th day of October, 2016, in the Board of Supervisors meeting room at the Mills County Courthouse in Glenwood with Supervisors Richard Crouch, Ron Kohn and Lonnie Mayberry present.

Motion by Crouch, seconded by Mayberry, to approve the October 25, 2016 agenda and the October 18, 2016 minutes as presented. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes 3: Nays: 0.

There were no utility permits to report this week.

Motion by Mayberry seconded by Crouch to approve voucher #1 for project BROS-CO65(99)—5F-65, 390<sup>th</sup> bridge replacement in the amount of \$34,934.66 and authorize the chair to sign the documents. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

Engineer Mayberry presented the Board with the current snow removal on-call list for winter 2016-2017.

Shawn Koehler and Randy Romens were present from the Mills County Trails Committee to update the Board on the current development and proposals of future projects.

Motion by Mayberry seconded by Crouch to approve the 4<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Crime Victim funding assistance request in the amount of \$400. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

Motion by Crouch seconded by Mayberry to approve FMLA papers for a Mills County employee. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

Motion by Crouch seconded by Mayberry to approve Resolution 16-27 – County Held Mobile Home Certificate

**Resolution 16-27**

The Mills County Board of Supervisors sitting in session on this 18th day of October, 2016 upon recommendation from the Treasurer and as per Senate file 478 and IA Code 445.16 shall abate the taxes, interest and penalties on the following described property and direct the County Treasurer to strike the amount due from the County system:

The Mills County Treasurer recommends that the taxes pertaining to the mobile home owned by Angela Marie Smith at Glenwood Mobile Home Park, FKA Fuoss Mobile Home Park in Glenwood, Mills County, IA, VIN M603917 in the total amount **\$2153.00** be abated for the prior tax years. The property will be purchased by Mark Reimann, dba Nothing New and he will be responsible for taxes going forward.

Richard Roenfeld was present to inquire about County owned property in Silver City. The County Attorney will look into the process to purchase with the Mills County Treasurer and Roenfeld will be notified of this process. Roenfeld has been mowing this piece of property for years that is approximately 16' wide and 13'7" long.

Carol Vinton joined the session at this time.

Mills County Sheriff Eugene Goos Emergency Management/E911 Communications Director Larry Hurst and Lynn Schrum were present to report on action taken at the Emergency Management Commissions meeting.

Motion by Crouch seconded by Mayberry to request that Hurst set an informational meeting to receive public input with regards to the Inoperable Communications Project and the funding options that are being explored. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

Darin Whatcott, Zoning Official from Building and Zoning was present to let the Board know that he had been approached by Glenwood Chief of Police Eric Johansen who will be in charge of the Code Enforcement department for the City of Glenwood. Whatcott and Johansen will meet to identify options to see if the Mills County Building & Zoning department can assist them.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, they adjourned to meet on Tuesday, November 1, 2016.
