The Board of Supervisors met this 15th day of November, 2016, in the Board of Supervisors meeting room at the Mills County Courthouse in Glenwood with Supervisors Richard Crouch, Ron Kohn and Lonnie Mayberry present.

Motion by Crouch, seconded by Mayberry, to approve the November 15, 2016 agenda and the November 1, 2016 minutes as presented and the November 8, 2016 minutes as corrected.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0.

There were no utility permits to report this week.

Motion by Mayberry seconded by Crouch to approve the driveway variance request near 64673 Painter Road with the condition that the exact location be determined by Engineer Mayberry and foreman.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

Motion by Crouch seconded by Mayberry to authorize the Engineer to purchase a new Townmaster Drop-Deck Trailer, Model T-12D with ramps from Bobcat of Omaha in the amount of \$7060 less the trade-in of a 2006 T-10P trailer in the amount of \$3050. The total cost is \$4010 with the trade.

Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

Engineer Mayberry updated the Board on several items:

He will attend the Silver City Council meeting on the 21<sup>st</sup> of November to discuss improvements on the Farm to Market extension through the Main Street that runs through Silver City

Mayberry went to Emerson at the request of the Iowa D.O.T. to investigate a complaint pertaining to the number of handicap parking stalls and parking stall markers.

Mills County Attorney Naeda Elliott (via teleconference), Mills County Treasurer Becky Killpack and City of Glenwood attorney Matt Woods were in attendance to propose a 28E Agreement between the City of Glenwood and the Mills County Treasurer for parking ticket fines to be added to city property tax collected by the Mills County Treasurer.

Motion by Mayberry seconded by Crouch to approve the 28E Agreement with the City of Glenwood for parking ticket collection. Motion carried on a vote: Ayes: 3 Nays: 0

Mrs. Dennis McFarland and Chief Deputy Kim Clark were present to discuss the timing of a subpoena served and the professionalism of the deputies.

Mrs. McFarland asked if they could come to a solution to this issue. She explained that she respects law enforcement and what they do but stated that 12:45 a.m. seems late for a subpoena to be served. It also frightens people when a police officer is standing at the door in the middle of the night. She asked why this couldn't have been done earlier in the day or perhaps the next day. She also felt that the deputy could have apologized for being there so late.

Chief Deputy Clark explained that the subpoena was from Pottawattamie County and they have a short turnaround time to get the subpoena served. She also stated that a deputy had been there earlier in the day and no one was home. She apologized and explained that the deputies had been busy that day and evening with calls and the civil service subpoena wasn't a first priority. The normal procedure for Mills County is to serve not later than 8:00-9:00 p.m. but this was from Pottawattamie County not Mills County and needed to be served due to time constraints.

Clark explained that the trainees are with a training officer and are not corrected in front of people but could possibly been talked to about professionalism after the fact.

The Board thanked Mrs. McFarland for informing them of the incident.
