

EXPLORE YOUR MILLS COUNTY PARKS!

Fisher Wildlife Area

2 miles east of Malvern on H-38(Lambert Rd)

Fisher Wildlife Area is 20 acres of land along the Nishnabotna River that provides access to the river. It consists of agricultural land, prairie and forest. It is a good area for nature viewing and a short hike. This park is open to hunting, please follow current Iowa DNR hunting regulations and laws.

This park is open to non-consumptive recreational use. It is illegal to remove, injure, destroy, or deface any natural or man-made structures or materials, including trees, flowers or wildlife except with written permission of the Mills County Conservation Board. Mushrooms, fruits and nuts can be harvested for personal use.

Please read over these basic rules for the park:

- **No motorized vehicles beyond the parking area**
- **No camping**
- **No open fires**
- **No fireworks**
- **Pets must remain on a leash at all times**
