

EXPLORE YOUR MILLS COUNTY PARKS!

Mile Hill Lake

This 39-acre area is composed of a hardwood forest, which is open to public hunting, as well as a 10-acre fishing lake with boat dock and ramp. The lake is considered a No Wake Zone and is closed to swimming. When driving down the asphalt into the park, you will find the handicap accessible Scenic Overlook, offering an interpretive panel discussing the Loess Hills Scenic Byway. There are various hiking trails within the park. This park is open to hunting, please follow current Iowa DNR hunting regulations and laws.

Crappie, blue gill, largemouth bass and channel catfish are some of the fish species found in the lake. Iowa DNR fishing regulations apply.

It is illegal to remove, injure, destroy, or deface any natural or man-made structures or materials, including trees, flowers or wildlife except with written permission of the Mills County Conservation Board. Mushrooms, fruits and nuts can be harvested for personal use.

Please read over these basic rules for the park:

- **No motorized vehicles beyond the parking area**
- **No camping**
- **No open fires**
- **No fireworks**
- **No swimming**
- **Pets must remain on a leash at all times**
