

EXPLORE YOUR MILLS COUNTY PARKS!

Pony Creek Access

(2.5 miles North of Hwy 34 on Deacon Rd)

This area is 2.7 acres of mowed area with a gravel parking area. It provides access to an 82-acre lake for shore fishermen and canoe enthusiasts. There is one picnic shelter located here with 2 group grills. The shelter can be reserved for a non-refundable fee of \$25.00 per day. The area also has picnic tables at 5 different pedestal grill sites for picnickers. Iowa DNR fishing regulations apply.

This park is open to non-consumptive recreational use. It is illegal to remove, injure, destroy, or deface any natural or man-made structures or materials, including trees, flowers or wildlife except with written permission of the Mills County Conservation Board. Mushrooms, fruits and nuts can be harvested for personal use.

Please read over these basic rules for the park:

- **No motorized vehicles beyond the parking area**
- **No hunting or trapping**
- **No firearms**
- **No camping**
- **No open fires**
- **No fireworks**
- **Pets must remain on a leash at all times**
