

**MILLS & MONTGOMERY COUNTIES
ROLLING PRAIRIE CASE MANAGEMENT 28E BOARD MEETING
THURSDAY, AUGUST 20, 11:00 A.M.
MONTGOMERY COUNTY COURTHOUSE, RED OAK, IOWA**

Six members of the 28E Board from Mills and Montgomery Counties met at 11:00 a.m., in the Montgomery County Courthouse. Members present included three members from Mills County Board of Supervisors, Ron Kohn, Richard Crouch and Joe Blankenship and three members from the Montgomery County Board of Supervisors, Glen Benskin, Donna Robinson and Bryant Amos.

The Director/Supervisor of Rolling Prairie Case Management gave a report on the agency. Discussion and handouts included:

- Discussion and review on how CPC/Case Management Director/Supervisor positions are funded;
- Update on Rolling Prairie Case Management staff & statistics;
- Discussion, and copies of minutes from, the RPCM '09 staff retreat;
- Discussion, and copies of, the survey from two 2009 RPCM Satisfaction Surveys – Client and Parent/Guardian;
- Discussion, and copies of, the Rolling Prairie Case Management Performance Improvement Plan for 2009-2010;
- Report on Federal Medicaid Law and discussion on how the law affects Case Management;
- Report on status of new law directing that CPC Applications be processed and services approved by County of Residence rather than County of Legal Settlement.

The 28E Board was reminded that they are responsible for the annual evaluation of the RPCM Director/Supervisor. The Director/Supervisor requested that the supervisors complete the evaluation within one month. No further business was introduced and the Board will plan to continue to meet annually.
