

**MILLS AND MONTGOMERY COUNTIES

28E BOARD MEETING

Five members of the 28E Board from Mills and Montgomery Counties met at 10:30 a.m., in the Mills County Courthouse. Members present included three members from the Mills County Board of Supervisors, Richard Crouch, Joe Blankenship, and Ron Kohn. Two members of the Montgomery County Board of Supervisors were also present, Bryant Amos and Donna Robinson. Montgomery County Board member Randy Tye was unable to attend.

The Director of Rolling Prairie Case Management gave a report on the agency. Discussion and handouts included:

Further business introduced included Supervisor Ron Kohn questioning how the State takeover of Medicaid payments as of July 1, 2012, has affected the Case Management program. The Director indicated this has resulted in sometimes lengthy waits for approvals for service additions and changes as these must be approved now at the state level. No further business was introduced and the Board will continue to meet annually. Richard Crouch of Mills County will facilitate the annual evaluation of the RPCM Director.
