

VICTIM REGISTRATION MILLS COUNTY

POLICE OR COUNTY SHERIFF: A local police department or county sheriff's department shall advise a victim of the right to register with the county attorney and shall provide a request for registration form to each victim. (915.11) (Victim of Serious Misdemeanor and above or Domestic Abuse)

JAILER: The County Sheriff or other person in charge of a jail or detention facility notifies registered victims of the following: 1. offender's release from custody on bail and terms and conditions of the release; 2. final release from local custody; 3. escape from custody; and 4. transfer from local custody to custody in another facility (915.17)
