Maximum dimensions and weight allowed on an annual oversize permit are:

- 120' long x 12'5" wide x 13'10" high - unlimited distance - no routing required
- 120' long x 14'6" wide x 15'5" high - movement restricted to 50 miles radius unless the route continues on at least 4-lane roads or trip routes are obtained from Motor Carrier Services.
- 120' long x 18" wide x 15'5" high - trip routes must be obtained.
- 75' long x 12'5" wide x 13'5" high - maximum dimensions for hauling hay.

Carrier will be responsible for obtaining necessary route approval prior to move. The Iowa Detour and Embargo map, Bridge Embargo map and vertical clearance maps should be used to obtain information for self routing.

Permits can be issued only for transporting, single articles that exceed statutory size unless the inclusion of additional articles does not cause the size or weight to further exceed the statutory limits.

Disclosure Statement: The information furnished on this application will be used by the Department of Transportation to prepare and issue permits. All information applicable to a given permit is required and is public information. Failure to complete the application as required will result in denial of permit. Permit issuing authorities will not be responsible for any damages that are the result of the move.
