

## **CHAPTER 6 - DUMPING AND BURNING**

### **6.1.1 Definitions**

- a.** Yard Waste: Yard waste means debris such as grass clipping, leaves, garden waste, brush and trees. Tree stumps are specifically included in this Section.
- b.** Tires: Tires mean all automotive rubber or rubber compound type tires including tractor and truck tires.
- c.** Debris: Debris means brick, lumber, wood, portland cement, trash, and household refuse, not included in any definitions above.
- d.** Burning: Burning means to destroy with fire.

### **6.1.2 Disposal of Rubbish**

It shall be unlawful for any person to dispose of any yard waste, tires, debris and household refuse or burn them upon any County owned property, roads or the right-of-way of any County maintained road.

### **6.1.3 Disposal of White Goods**

It shall be unlawful for any person to dispose of any furniture, refrigerators, stoves, washers, dryers, dishwashers, or other white goods upon County owned property, roads or the right-of-way of any County maintained road.

### **6.1.4 Penalty**

Violation of the Chapter shall be a County infraction and subject to a Civil Penalty as defined in Chapter 5 – Violations And Penalties of the Mills County Code of Ordinances.

### **6.1.5 Residential Solid Waste Limitations**

Each dwelling unit shall be allowed no more than two (2) thirty-three (33) gallon trash containers per week. Each container shall weigh no more than fifty (50) pounds. The solid waste hauler shall set a reasonable fee for additional containers and shall enforce said fee.
