Board of Supervisors Committee/Meeting Updates

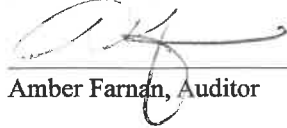

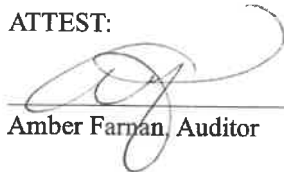
