Will have a 28E with City of Tabor for law enforcement services for next meeting

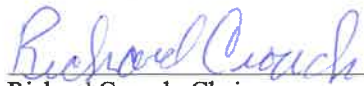

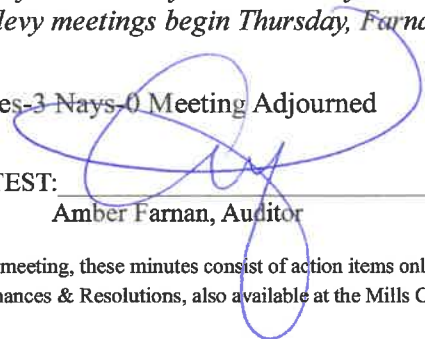
